

How does the voucher program work?

- You'll receive vouchers you can use like checks to reimburse drivers for travel you need.
- You recruit your own drivers
- Additional transportation options may be available to meet individual needs.
- You'll develop your own individualized transportation plan.
- Your Individualized Transportation Plan includes your monthly funding allocation for voucher program travel.
- Since the program could end depending on funding, you'll work with the Transportation Coordinator to ensure you are able to continue getting where you need to go
- Public transit rides are not eligible for reimbursement

Who is eligible for the North Country Transportation Voucher Program?

- People with disabilities who live in North Country's eight-county region, in areas not served by public transportation and
- do not have adequate access to transportation and
- have income at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Level. (\$25,760 for an individual in 2021)

And you'll be able to use vouchers to pay for transportation, either with a friend or family member or with other transportation providers North Country works with.
